The Easter season is quickly coming to an end. We celebrate Ascension Thursday this week, and then we join with the whole Church to pray for a renewal of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Of course, our Greek Orthodox neighbors are just celebrating Easter today, so we say to them: "Χριστός Ανέστη!" "*Christos anesti*!" "Christ is Risen!" Christ Risen from the dead is our hope and our salvation. May the joy of this holy season remain in our hearts always.

"This I command you: love one another." These are the final words of Jesus in our gospel passage on this Sixth Sunday of Easter. At the Transfiguration, the appearance of Moses and

Elijah with Jesus was an indication that Jesus came to fulfill the law and the prophets. When Jesus was questioned about the greatest of the commandments of the law, He instructed the crowd to love God and to love our neighbor. In John's gospel, the Last Supper begins in chapter 13 and concludes with the High Priestly Prayer of Jesus in chapter 17. Today's passage, from chapter 15, is among the Last Supper discourses recorded by John. Jesus reminds us: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." Clearly these are not mere words for Jesus: He lived them out by dying on the cross for our salvation. May we find in the crosses we carry as disciples of the Lord the means to manifest our love for God and one another.

As many of you know, Sal Colak died back in March and the funeral and burial took place in Croatia. Sal was a faithful and dedicated parishioner with his wife and family, and he committed himself to the St. Luke Athletic Association, the Carnival, and the Christmas tree lighting for many years. His family has scheduled a Memorial Mass here at St. Luke on Saturday, June 29<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 PM. I am sure many parishioners would like to join the family in remembering him and his friendship and service to our community. May Sal rest in peace and may all who mourn know the comfort and compassion of the Lord.

Today Monsignor John Strynkowski returns to St. Luke for a Mass of Thanksgiving. His 60+ years of priestly ministry have allowed him to share his gifts in parish ministry, in priestly formation, as an author, and in service to the Church both at the Vatican and in Washington, D.C. We were privileged to have him preside at liturgies here at St. Luke since he became a senior priest some ten years ago. He endeared himself to many parishioners and inspired many people with his words and example. While Monsignor may continue to return from time to time, he will no longer regularly serve on weekends here at St. Luke. We assure Monsignor Strynkowski of our love, thoughts and prayers. *Ad multos annos!*
