As you know, Msgr. John Strykowski was a regular weekend assistant here at St. Luke as a Senior Priest for many years. Since he moved out to Huntington, it was getting more difficult for him to commit to weekly assistance here at St. Luke, and so he “retired” again over the winter. Although he may come back to “pinch hit” from time to time, since his regular ministry has come to an end, he will come back for a Mass of Thanksgiving next Sunday, May 5th at 10:30 AM. After Mass we will have a simple breakfast reception so that parishioners may have the opportunity to speak with Monsignor and enjoy some time with one another. Please mark your calendars!

If you check the parish Facebook page from time to time, I try to share inspirational memes, videos, and articles that parishioners may find of interest. When it comes to websites, I would certainly recommend Bishop Barron’s *Word on Fire*. He posts videos and podcasts, and he has an online store with wonderful Catholic resources. In terms of apps, I personally use iBreviary every day. This app provides the Liturgy of the Hours – the daily prayer of the Church – in many different languages. It also provides readings for daily Mass, and a host of other prayers. A new app is called Hallow. Hallow provides a daily Rosary, *lectio divina*, Catholic music, prayers, and many other resources, including links to *Bible in a Year* and *Catechism in a Year* podcasts by Fr. Mike Schmitz. While I haven’t yet personally used it much, I see great potential for inspiration and formation in what I have seen. Please let me know of your favorite Catholic websites and apps.

On this Fifth Sunday of Easter, we read in John’s Gospel: “I am the vine, you are the branches.” John’s Gospel records 7 “I am” statements made by Jesus: (1) I am the Bread of Life (6:35); (2) I am the Light of the World (8:12); (3) I am the Door (10:9); (4) I am the Good Shepherd (10:11, 14); (5) I am the Resurrection and the Life (11:25); (6) I am the Way and the Truth and the Life (14:6); (7) I am the Vine (15:1,5). I AM hearkens back to Moses hearing the voice of God in the burning bush, where God identifies Himself as I AM. As branches of the Vine, we need regular nourishment from Jesus so that we can bear fruit in all that we say and do. As we hear this weekend’s gospel, perhaps we need to assess the quality of the fruit that we are bearing as disciples of Jesus. How do I need to be pruned by the Lord?

The Parish Council is sponsoring a plant sale on Mother’s Day weekend. Please plan on buying gifts for mom and supporting the parish at this event. Looking ahead, we have set a date for Radio Bingo in the fall. If you wish to “Save the Date,” plan on joining us on September 28th.
