With public schools finally closed, the summer has truly begun. We pray for Fr. Chin as he heads to Vietnam to visit his family and to be with his sister as she makes her final profession as a consecrated religious. I am grateful to Bishop Chappetto and Fr. Krlis for their availability to help us with Masses during the summer. Juan will be here through the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July.

From the 5<sup>th</sup> chapter of Mark’s gospel we hear two wonderful healing stories this weekend. First, Jairus, a synagogue official, asks Jesus to lay hands on his daughter, who is at the point of death. Jesus immediately goes off with him, and on the way, a woman who has suffered with hemorrhages for 12 years recognizes Jesus passing by and reaches for his cloak: "If I but touch his clothes, I shall be cured." Although the crowd was pressing in on him, he knows that someone was desperately seeking a healing from Him: "Who touched me?" She approaches him with fear and trembling and tells Him the whole truth: "Daughter, your faith has saved you. Go in peace and be cured of your affliction." As he approaches the house of Jairus, news greets them: "Your daughter has died." Jesus tells Jairus: "Do not be afraid; just have faith." Jesus enters the house amid the weeping and wailing. "*Talitha koum – Little girl, I say to you, arise!*" The twelve-year-old girl immediately arose and walked around. These two stories are both rooted in faith: "Your faith has saved you ... do not be afraid; just have faith." The saving power of faith is timeless. Lord, increase our faith!

On Wednesday we celebrate the feast of St. Thomas the Apostle. While he is infamous for being "Doubting Thomas" after the resurrection, he is revered in India, where he travelled as an apostle to spread the gospel. He was martyred there in the year 72 AD. In John’s gospel, Thomas has a great dialogue with Jesus. The Lord is trying to prepare His apostles for His imminent death, and He speaks of preparing a place for them in the kingdom. Jesus: "Where I am going you know the way." Thomas: "Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?" Jesus: "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." Many of us might remember our first Missals when we made our First Holy Communion. I remember that the page opposite the host being held after the consecration quoted the words of St. Thomas when he finally saw the Risen Lord after Easter: "My Lord and My God." May St. Thomas intercede for us in our doubts, and renew us in our faith in the Lord, our God.

Thursday is Independence Day. As a nation, we celebrate the 248<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Declaration of Independence, which marks the birth of our nation. The founding fathers, while declaring independence from Great Britain, also acknowledged that our true freedoms come from God: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." In anticipation of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July, I invite parishioners to join us on Monday evening for a period of Eucharistic Adoration by the shrine of Our Lady in the garden behind the rectory from 7:00 to 9:00 PM. Let us worship the Lord, Who sets us free!

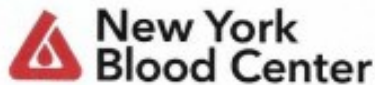
