On August 4th we traditionally celebrate the memorial of St. John Marie Vianney, the patron saint of priests. John was not a good student and he struggled to make it through the seminary. After ordination he served as a faithful and holy priest and was eventually assigned to be the pastor of the parish in Ars. He lived an austere life and dedicated himself to preaching and reconciling his parishioners to the Lord. He is known to have spent many, many hours in the confessional, and people would come from long distances to go to confession to the Curé of Ars. Here at St. Luke, we have a statue of St. John Vianney by the staircase that leads to the sacristy. In your charity, please pray for the priests of our parish, of our diocese, and

for all priests. Also, pray for vocations to the priesthood, that we may all strive to be holy priests through the intercession of St. John Marie Vianney.

On this 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time, we continue to hear from the sixth chapter of John’s Gospel. Last week Jesus fed the crowds with bread, and when he left, they followed him to Capernaum: “Do not work for food that perishes but for food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you.” He reminds the people that during the time of Moses, they were fed with manna, but the manna was a gift from God, not from Moses. Then, Jesus says, “I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst.” As we continue to listen to the Bread of Life Discourse in John’s Gospel during the month of August, may we renew our Eucharistic devotion as individuals and as a community. That renewal begins with a commitment to worship every Sunday with our family of faith. While we all have our own personal relationship with the Lord through prayer, we are called to be a community of believers who support one another through prayer, companionship, and charity.

On August 6th the Church celebrates the Transfiguration of the Lord. We also recall this special moment in the life of Christ every year on the second Sunday of Lent. Jesus brings Peter, James and John up the mountain to pray, and suddenly Jesus is seen in dazzling white, with Moses and Elijah beside him. This moment symbolizes Jesus fulfilling the Law and the Prophets, and a voice identifies Jesus as the Beloved Son of the Father. As followers of Jesus, we are called to be faithful to Him, the Beloved Son. By following the commandments of the Law, summarized by Jesus in our Love of God and neighbor, we extend the mission of the apostles to our own day. In all that we say and do, may we be transfigured as disciples of the Lord.

I want to remind parishioners that St. Luke School and the Religious Education Program are still accepting registrations for the upcoming school year. We are blessed with an excellent faculty and staff in our school, and also with dedicated volunteer catechists in our Religious Education Program. Unlike academic subjects where students learn math or science, we talk about formation in the Catholic faith. The teachings of the Church are not simply about learning, but about changing our lives by what we learn about Jesus and the Church he established.

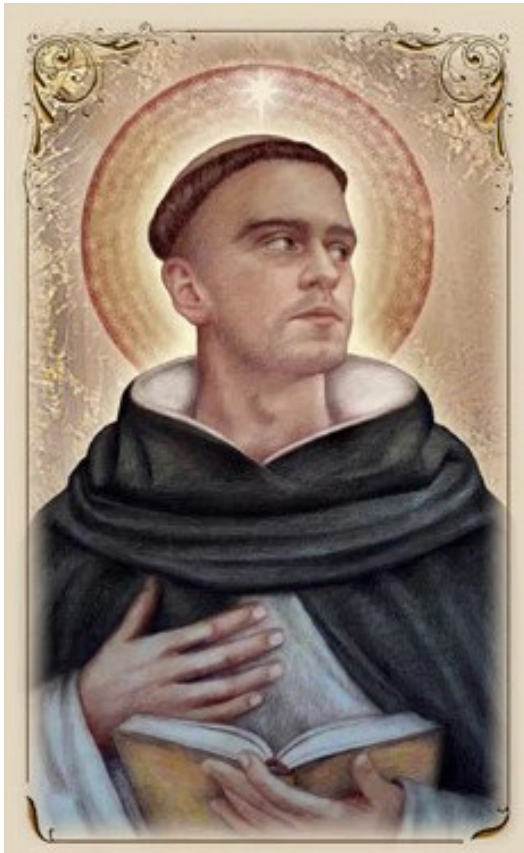
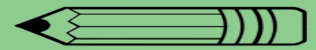

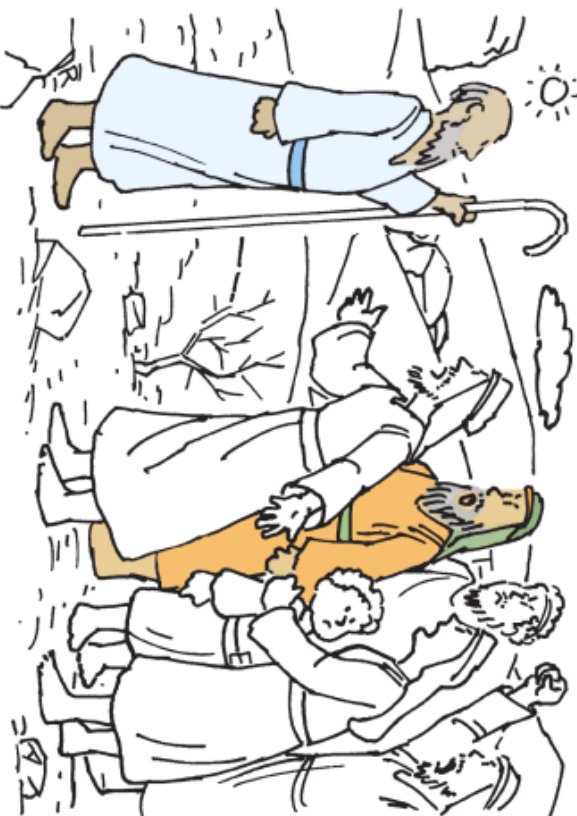
