

My pilgrimage to Italy begins today. As you know, I lived in Rome for ten years, and so the Eternal City is a second home to me. Over the next two weeks we will be in Rome, Assisi, Loreto, San Giovanni Rotondo (Padre Pio), Pompeii and Cassino. Italy is beautiful this time of year, and I'm sure the pilgrims will enjoy the opportunity to visit some very holy places like the tombs of St. Peter, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Padre Pio, St. Benedict and St. Scholastica, as well as the many special sites in Rome and in other places in Italy. I am particularly looking forward to visiting the tomb of soon-to-be Saint Carlo Acutis while we are in Assisi. You can be sure of my prayers for all of you throughout the next two weeks. At the end, I will extend my visit for one day so I can

attend the diaconate ordination of Paulo Salazar, a Brooklyn seminarian who was at Cathedral Seminary House of Formation in Douglaston when I was the vice rector there. God-willing, Paulo, along with Callistus, Juan, and the rest of their classmates, will be ordained to the priesthood on June 28, 2025.

Every year, we celebrate St. Padre Pio with a procession between St. Luke and St. Mel, followed by Mass. We also have an annual dinner-dance to raise money to support the hospital founded by St. Padre Pio in San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy. His feast day is tomorrow, Monday, September 23rd. Because I will be away on pilgrimage, we will have the procession from St. Luke to St. Mel on Friday, October 11th. The dinner-dance will be held on October 6th. It's a blessing for our community to honor this great saint every year, and to help promote the important work he began to bring healing and hope to the sick.

Speaking of the sick, next Saturday our parish will celebrate a Mass for the Anointing of the Sick in the Pastoral Center at 12:00 Noon. Our young people preparing for Confirmation will be on hand to help, and a simple luncheon will be served after Mass. As always, I like to remind parishioners that the sacrament is no longer *Extreme Unction*, but a sacrament that can be received in preparation for surgery, at the onset of a serious illness, and even when we are seniors with the normal aches and pains of getting older. If a family member is beginning hospice care, please have a priest come to the facility or to the family home to offer the hope and healing of this wonderful sacrament while the family member is able to spiritually benefit from the opportunity to go to confession, be anointed, and receive Holy Communion. Please respond either by calling the rectory or returning the form in the bulletin so we can properly prepare.

The Radio Bingo fundraiser will take place next Saturday evening. It promises to be a fun evening of music, dancing, laughs, and prizes. Tickets must be sold in advance, so please return the form in the bulletin as soon as possible, or use the QR code to register online. I am glad to see such community events returning to St. Luke. I hope that this will be the beginning of other opportunities to bring people together to have fun with one another and to support our wonderful parish.
