As I write this (on Monday, September 30th), I have just celebrated Mass for the pilgrims at the Shrine of Our Lady of Pompeii in the shadow of Mount Vesuvius. Back in 1872, a lawyer came to the plain of Pompeii to handle the affairs of a local Countess. While there, he and his wife began to spread the Rosary among the sharecroppers and farmers of the area. They inaugurated a confraternity of the Rosary and needed a picture of the Blessed Mother before which the group could pray the Rosary every day. A local monastery donated an image that was acquired from a junk-shop dealer in Naples; it portrayed Our Lady of the Rosary with St. Dominic and St. Catherine of Siena. Soon, miracles were reported and pilgrims frequently came to visit Pompeii.

Eventually, a new church was built and the image was restored several times, the last time during the Pontificate of Pope St. Paul VI, who said, "just as the image of the Virgin has been repaired and decorated, so may the image of Mary that all Christians must have within themselves be restored, renovated, and enriched." As we begin the month of October, the month of the Holy Rosary, may we be restored, renovated, and enriched through our Blessed Mother's intercession.

We have been truly blessed during our pilgrimage. We visited all four of the major basilicas in Rome and were privileged to celebrate Mass in St. Paul Outside-the-Walls and St. Mary Major. During the Wednesday audience with Pope Francis, the pilgrims from "St. Luke, Whitestone" were welcomed and blessed. Next, we travelled to Assisi, where we celebrated Mass at the tomb of St. Francis of Assisi, and we prayed before the tomb of soon-to-be Saint Carlo Acutis. On our way to San Giovanni Rotondo, we made a brief visit to Lanciano to visit the site of a Eucharistic Miracle that goes back to the 8th century. In San Giovanni Rotondo we celebrated Mass at an altar frequently used by Padre Pio, and then had a chance to visit his tomb. Today, on our way to Pompeii, we stopped at a cave dedicated to St. Michael the Archangel. After Pompeii we will make our way to Monte Cassino, the burial place of the twins St. Benedict and St. Scholastica. On Thursday, I will be at St. Peter's Basilica for the ordination of Paulo Salazar to the diaconate, and then I will fly back on Friday. Of course, if you are reading this, I will already be back! A pilgrimage is not a vacation, but it is a wonderful opportunity to visit holy places and to be inspired by the lives of the saints and special and important places for our Catholic faith. I know several parishioners are interested in visiting the Holy Land if there is ever a peaceful time to return, but there are many other shrines and holy places all around the world that might be worthwhile to consider for our parish in the future. Let me know!

Tomorrow is the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, and October is the month of the Rosary. Later this month we celebrate the feast of St. Luke. There is a tradition that says that St. Luke was an artist and used the top of a table made by Jesus in his father's shop to paint an image of Mary. As she posed for the painting, she told Luke stories of the life of Jesus, which he then included in his gospel. As parishioners of St. Luke parish, I pray that we can always remain close to Mary, especially through praying the Rosary.




Book Assembly Instructions:


Note: If you wish to color these pictures, it's best to color them before you assemble the mini book.



1: Cut along the dotted lines. When finished, you should have only 4 strips of paper with the mini book's pages. —as pictured




2: Fold each of the strips along the solid vertical lines. Fold them like a fan. The first and last mini pages should be facing toward the outside. (They should be visible after the strips are folded.)



 Stack the folded strips together in the correct order.



4: Staple the mini book at the outside left edge.
