

We are a little ahead of last year in terms of reaching our goal for the Annual Catholic Appeal. Thank you to all who have made gifts and pledges to help us arrive at 95% of our goal! I am confident that we will reach and surpass the goal as we always do ... and I appreciate that any monies collected over the goal will return to St. Luke. As I mentioned earlier, our budget is in the red by about \$1,000 per week. As you can see, work is being done on the church building to deal with some water issues; the cost of this project is about \$30,000. Any help to offset that cost will be greatly appreciated.

Every year during October, the month of the Rosary, the school community gathers for a Rosary Rally to honor Mary. On this Wednesday, October 16th, at 8:30 AM, the school community will gather in the church to pray the Rosary. Since October is also Breast Cancer Awareness month, we will pray in a special way for the victims and survivors of breast cancer. Parishioners are welcome to join us for this special time of prayer. Of course, October is also Respect Life month, so we pray that all human life, from conception to natural death, will be defended and protected, especially as our country prepares for elections next month.

I want to express my gratitude to the members of the Parish Pastoral Council. While I was on my pilgrimage, they hosted Radio Bingo, which turned out to be a lot of fun for all who participated. They are already looking ahead to arranging it again for next year. Now, they are organizing Novemberfest ... Oktoberfest in November. There will be German music, dancing, food and beer. Please plan on joining us on November 16th! Looking ahead, they are considering a Mardi Gras celebration for families. I am so glad that we are sponsoring these kinds of community-building activities.



In this weekend's passage from the Gospel of St. Mark, Jesus encourages the rich man to sell his possessions, give to the poor, and follow Him. Mark reports that the rich man went away sad because he had many possessions. Jesus then teaches his disciples: "It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." In cities like Jerusalem, there was a small door inside a larger door at the gates of the city. For most pedestrian traffic, people could easily walk through "the eye of the needle," the

smaller of the doors. When a caravan of camels would arrive, the larger door needed to be opened because the animals carrying all their wares could never fit through "the eye of the needle." Jesus reminds his disciples – and us – that we should not allow our possessions to weigh us down and prevent us from entering the kingdom of God.

On Friday, October 18th, we celebrate the feast of our parish patron, St. Luke. May Luke's love of the Word of God and the Blessed Mother inspire our community to deepen our faith and to be more faithful witnesses to God's love. *St. Luke, pray for us!*

Our Church is open for private prayer from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm each weekday. Take advantage of the opportunity to spend some quiet time in prayer and reflection.






Note: If you wish to color these pictures, it's best to color them before you assemble the mini book.



1: Cut along the dotted lines. When finished, you should have only 4 strips of paper with the mini book's pages. —as pictured



2: Fold each of the strips along the solid vertical lines. Fold them like a fan. The first and last mini pages should be facing toward the outside. (They should be visible after the strips are folded.)



Stack the folded strips together in the correct order.



Staple the mini book at the outside left edge.
