Here we are at the final days of October! Halloween is Thursday, All Saints Day is Friday, All Souls Day is Saturday, and the clocks go back an hour at 2:00 AM on Sunday. It's been a beautiful fall so far, but the days will get shorter and colder, and the autumn colors will soon fade away. Enjoy every precious moment as God's gift!

Once again, our parish is an early election polling site. I thank you for your patience during this upcoming week, but I believe it's an

important service to our community to have an easy-access site with ample parking to help facilitate these very important elections. While I will never instruct anyone to vote for one political candidate over another, I certainly encourage every legally registered voter to cast their ballot for this and every election. With regard to issues on the ballot, I included in the bulletin a few weeks ago the position of the NY State Catholic Conference in regard to Proposal One. The bishops believe that passing this proposal will permanently permit abortion without restriction and up until the moment of birth in New York. The proposal also would make "age" a protected class, which could lead to parents' rights over their minor children to be stripped away. I strongly agree with the NY State Bishops' recommendation to vote "NO" to Proposal One.

These are exciting days for the sports enthusiasts among us! Congratulations to the WNBA's New York Liberty for their first championship win! Turning to baseball, the New York Mets made a valiant effort but didn't bring a Subway Series back to New York. Instead, an old rivalry between the Yankees and the Dodgers is playing itself out in the World Series. I'm sure many parishioners will follow the games this week and hope for the 28th victory of the New York Yankees!

On this 30th Sunday of Ordinary Time, we hear about the healing of the blind man, Bartimaeus, in today's passage from Mark's gospel. "Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me!" When he first calls out for Jesus, he is rebuked by the crowd. When Jesus calls for him, the crowd encourages Bartimaeus as he is brought to the Lord. "Master, I want to see." "Your faith has saved you." Jesus, we want to see! Save us, Lord!





On Monday this week, the Church celebrates the Feast of Saints Simon and Jude. There is little known about these Apostles, but many people turn to Saint Jude with their "impossible" or "desperate" causes. Both Simon and Jude are buried in St. Peter's Basilica at the St. Joseph altar, which is located in the left transept. Besides a separate chapel that is set aside for private prayer, this altar is the only other place at St. Peter's Basilica where there is a tabernacle. Saints Simon and Jude, pray for us!


Note: If you wish to color these pictures, it's best to color them before you assemble the mini book.

2: Fold each of the strips along the solid vertical lines. Fold them like a fan. The first and last mini pages should be facing toward the outside. (They should be visible after the strips are folded.)



Stack the folded strips together in the correct order.



Staple the mini book at the outside left edge.
