On this first weekend of November, we hear a very important theme for our lives as followers of Jesus: the commandment to love. Jesus teaches us to love God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength, and to love our neighbor as ourselves. With this teaching Jesus brings fulfillment to the teachings of the law found in the Old Testament. While we often think of the law in terms of prohibitions and restrictions, this positive perspective improves our ability to properly orient our thoughts, words, and deeds to doing what is right instead of avoiding what is wrong. Let us all strive to love God and to love our neighbor.

My apologies. I was in Huntington last weekend giving a retreat to deacons. I failed to make sure that the collection for hurricane victims would be taken up by the ushers at all Masses. We will take that collection this weekend. There are also signs around the church with a QR code that will allow you to make a donation with your credit card using Give Central. I thank you in advance for your generous response.

Our Pastoral Center has been very busy with early voting this past week. This weekend early voting is available from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM on both Saturday and Sunday. St. Luke does NOT host voting on Election Day, so, if you do not vote early you need to go to your regular polling place to vote on Tuesday. I am grateful to all parishioners for your patience and understanding this past week.





This week I received an email from a woman who was packing and came across a photo of her parents' wedding. Marianne and William Clancy were married at St. Luke on September 20, 1947. They moved to Florida in 1962 and were parents to 10 children; their children had 22 children; the next generation has given birth to an additional 9. People are proud of their roots here in Whitestone and at St. Luke, so I thought I'd share what was sent to me.

Next Saturday both Callistus Ibeh and Juan Herrera will be ordained deacons at St. Joseph Seminary in Yonkers. As you remember, Callistus was here for his Pastoral Year 2022-2023, and Juan served here this past summer. Since they are on the path to be ordained priests next June, ordination to the diaconate is transitional. We pray for them and all their classmates, that their ministry of service as deacons will help them as they prepare to serve the Diocese of Brooklyn as priests.

I have been involved with the Pro Sanctity Movement for over 35 years. The Secular Institute of the Apostolic Oblates live in St. Kevin Convent in Flushing, but when I was newly ordained they lived in the convent at Our Lady of Miracles. They were founded by Servant of God Guglielmo Giaquinta shortly after World War II in Rome, and their apostolate is dedicated to promoting the Universal Call to Holiness. Bishop Giaquinta used to say, "All saints, all brothers and sisters," and All Saints Day is an important feast for the movement. Next Saturday at 11:15 AM I will celebrate a Mass for the Pro Sanctity Movement here at St. Luke, and a light reception will follow. All are welcome.
