Tomorrow our nation celebrates Veterans Day to honor all the women and men who served defending our country. The Whitestone community has many proud veterans living among us, and we thank them for their service, whether they served during a time of conflict or a time of peace. We will certainly remember them when we celebrate Mass tomorrow at 9:30 AM. Please join us in prayer tomorrow!

In today's passage from Mark's gospel, we hear about "the widow's mite." "A poor widow also came and put in two small coins worth a few cents." Jesus commended her contribution compared to the large sums put in by many rich people: "she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood." At this time of year, we realize how blessed we are in so many ways. Most of us have no problem gathering with family and friends for the upcoming holidays and providing a luscious banquet for our loved ones. Homes will be richly decorated for the holidays, and there will be plenty of gifts under the tree on Christmas morning. At the same time, there are many among us who have no family or who can't travel to join them. Their homes will not be decorated, and there will be no gifts under the tree. Let's not forget them. Invite elderly neighbors to join your family if you know they will otherwise be alone. Teach children to share baked goods and gifts with neighbors who might otherwise go without. Soon we will collect food for Thanksgiving and gifts for Christmas. Please be generous and take every opportunity to share your blessings with others.

This week we celebrate the feast of Mother Frances Xavier Cabrini. Mother Cabrini had a missionary's heart and wanted to leave Italy and go east to China. The Holy Father asked her to go west instead, since many Italian immigrants arriving in America were in need of assistance. She obediently came to New York and faced many hardships as she tried to provide for the Italian immigrants, especially the children and the sick among them. Despite many obstacles, Mother Cabrini persevered, and she and her sisters established 67 missionary institutions to serve the sick and poor all over the United States and elsewhere. Nine years after her death, her Community achieved Mother Cabrini's original goal of becoming missionaries to China. A beautiful statue of Mother Cabrini welcomes the faithful at the main entrance of our church, and the center stained glass window by the choir honors this great patron saint of immigrants. We will celebrate Mass in honor of St. Frances Xavier Cabrini on her feast day, Wednesday, November 13th at 12:00 Noon.


