We had beautiful celebrations for the Triduum, especially on Holy Saturday, when we celebrated baptism for one adult and Communion and Confirmation for five additional adults. Once again, I thank everyone – clergy, staff, ministers, and volunteers – who helps to make our celebrations so beautiful and prayerful. We are truly blessed here at St. Luke!

On the other hand, while we had good crowds, our numbers were down a bit from last year, and contributions were also down as well. I hope and pray that as the weather gets warmer and we prepare to celebrate First Holy Communion and other special events, that more parishioners will join us and support us.



Of course, after all the blessings of Holy Week and Easter, we woke up on Easter Monday morning to the news that our Holy Father, Pope Francis, passed away. I was blessed to be in St. Peter’s Square when he was elected Pope in 2013, and I had the opportunity to be greeted by him when I took part in a conference for seminary formators in 2017. After his weekly audience, he posed for a photo with our group. I was able to take this photo of him – I thought it was a different perspective from other photos of the Pope. Traditionally there are nine days of mourning after the death of the Holy Father, and the Cardinals from around the world gather

together to conduct meetings and begin to discuss the needs of the Church as they prepare to elect a new Pope. For now, we pray for the repose of the soul of Pope Francis; may the Lord grant him eternal peace. We also join the Church in praying to the Holy Spirit, that the Cardinals will rely on the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit as they begin the process of choosing a new Pope.

This is Divine Mercy Sunday. I hope many parishioners will join us for a holy hour at 3:00 PM on Sunday. Jesus, I trust in you!

One immediate consequence of the Holy Father’s death is that the Church has to postpone the canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Since a canonization takes place under the authority of the Supreme Pontiff, no canonizations can take place until a new Holy Father has been elected. This period is called Sede Vacante, which means that the Pope’s Seat of Authority is currently vacant. There were thousands of young people and pilgrims scheduled to be in Rome this weekend for the canonization. I am sure they are very disappointed. The whole Church has been anticipating the canonization of the first millennial saint who wore khakis, carried a cell phone and a water bottle, and was known for his kindness and his love for the Eucharist. We pray that the new Holy Father will re-schedule the canonization as soon as possible so that we can turn to St. Carlo for his intercession and his holy example.
