On this last weekend of May the Church celebrates the Most Holy Trinity: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. You can find the Church’s teaching on the Holy Trinity in the Catechism of the Catholic Church beginning at n. 249:

The Trinity is One. We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons, the "consubstantial Trinity." The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole and entire: "The Father is that which the Son is, the Son that which the

Father is, the Father and the Son that which the Holy Spirit is, i.e. by nature one God (n. 253). The Catechism continues:

The divine persons are really distinct from one another. "God is one but not solitary." "Father," "Son," "Holy Spirit" are not simply names designating modalities of the divine being, for they are really distinct from one another: "He is not the Father who is the Son, nor is the Son he who is the Father, nor is the Holy Spirit he who is the Father or the Son." They are distinct from one another in their relations of origin: "It is the Father who generates, the Son who is begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds." The divine Unity is Triune (n.254).

As I write this, I anticipate that the Carnival will return this week. I pray for good weather and for a safe and fun time for all. So many volunteers have come forward to help with this year’s Carnival. A full listing will be included in the bulletin when we report the results of the Carnival, but I would like to thank in a special way Sabato Daniele, John Dierks, and Damian Scardamaglia. We are grateful for the generous response and support of the whole community.

As the calendar page turns to June this week, we anticipate graduation and the conclusion of the academic year at St. Luke School. As always, we are grateful to Mrs. Brunswick, Mrs. Mezic, and the entire faculty and staff for their dedication, commitment, and personal sacrifices to provide an excellent Catholic education to the families of our community. We are also grateful to the parents who entrust their children to St. Luke School to allow us to collaborate with them as the first teachers of their children in the practice of the faith. As you know, a number of Catholic Academies are closing at the end of this academic year. It is getting more and more difficult to sustain a Catholic School, and so we rely on the generous support of friends and parishioners, particularly with our fundraisers, to help us to keep our programs going. I am grateful for all you do for St. Luke School.

Next weekend we will continue our tradition of a Corpus Christi procession on Saturday after the 4:30 PM Mass. In my experience, a procession on the Vigil allows us to move through the streets without the strongest heat of the day. We especially invite the children who received First Holy Communion and the young people who were confirmed to join us for the procession as we bring our faith into the streets of our community. Anyone along the route who would like to set up an altar for a blessing is asked to contact Fr. Chin as soon as possible.

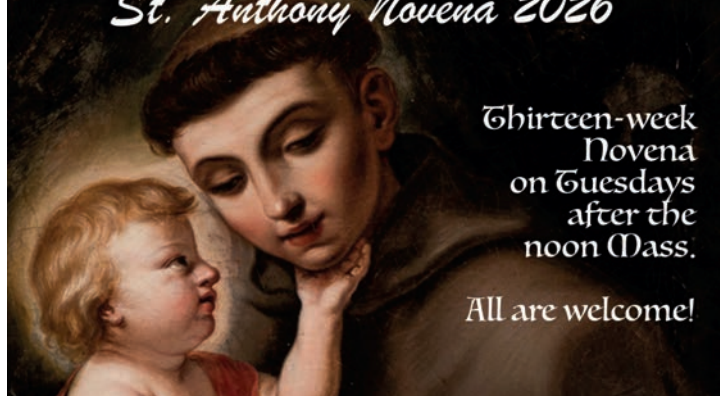

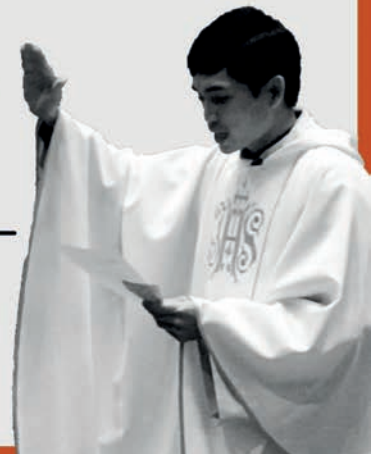


Celebrating Fr. Chin!
