Dear Friends,

It's Labor Day weekend, and so it's the unofficial end of the summer. Most college students have already started their new semester, and younger students are ready to begin this week. The faculty and staff of St. Luke School have been hard at work getting ready for the new academic year. I will celebrate a Mass with the faculty on Tuesday when they return for their first faculty meeting, and the students will return on Wednesday. We turn to the

Holy Spirit and ask God's blessings of wisdom, knowledge and understanding on teachers and students alike. Both St. Luke School and our religious education program are still accepting registrations for new and returning students. We are truly grateful to Mrs. Brunswick, Sr. Katherine, and all the faculty and staff in both programs for their dedication and commitment to the young people of our community.

In today's passage from Matthew's gospel we hear Jesus' teaching on fraternal correction. He first recommends that we deal with the other person one-on-one. If the other is not persuaded, then we should ask a couple of others to join us to give more evidence and credibility to our concerns. If that doesn't work, then we should bring it to a more official level so that those in authority in the community can weigh in. Fraternal correction is rooted in charity and tries to preserve the dignity of the other as we try to help them see their faults or failings and hopefully have a change of heart. In my role as episcopal vicar, my experience is that sometimes people choose the "nuclear option" of writing directly to the bishop before speaking first directly with the person of concern in the local parish. I usually try to follow the gospel teaching and start with the individual so that we can hopefully resolve it there. The gospel teaching ends with a wonderful reassurance from the Lord: "where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." We rely on Jesus always whenever we are dealing with concerns or situations that affect us, and we are grateful for His guidance and love.

On Tuesday we celebrate the birthday of the Blessed Mother. Since she is the Immaculate Conception, which we celebrate on December 8th each year, it follows that, nine months later, we should celebrate her birth. We send Mary gifts of love and prayers on her birthday and we know that, because she is our Mother and the Mother of God, she will shower us with gifts in return. In the Catholic tradition, our devotion to Mary is geared toward bringing us closer to Jesus, the greatest gift that Mary bestowed on the world through the power of the Holy Spirit at work within her. Let us join with the whole Church as we celebrate her birthday this week.

Of course, our nation marks the 25th anniversary of the attacks on our nation on Friday, September 11th. For those of us who were alive on that day in 2001, it doesn't take much to recall how terrible and horrible that day was. For those among us who were first responders or worked in lower Manhattan in the days after the attacks, too many people continue to suffer in the aftermath of that event. Here at St. Luke we will provide a Holy Hour on the Vigil: Thursday, September 10th at 7:00 PM. I think giving a special opportunity for quiet prayer before the Lord can be a meaningful way for many of us to be with Jesus and to ask Him to continue to console and comfort us. We will provide a table in front of the altar for photos of victims and first responders so that they can be included in our prayers in a special way.
